Expression of Interest Cultural Educators

Murray City Country Coast GP Training (MCCC) is a new Regional Training Organisation responsible for the management and delivery of specialist general practice training programs across North Western and North Eastern Victoria, the greater Albury region into Southern New South Wales, central Victoria, South Western Victoria and Northern and Western metropolitan Melbourne area which covers approximately 40% of the population base of Melbourne.

MCCC is seeking expressions of interest from suitably experienced people within our local Aboriginal Community Controlled Health Organisations (ACCHSs) and/or local aboriginal community members to take on these important roles working in collaboration with our Aboriginal Health program staff and Cultural Mentors.

Cultural Educators will work in partnership with Medical Educators of a local MCCC GP Training region to develop, deliver and evaluate Cultural Awareness Training Activities for GP Registrars, and other groups as appropriate.

The following attributes are essential for the Cultural Educator role:

- Must be an Aboriginal person
- Sound knowledge of the local Aboriginal Community History
- Demonstrated understanding and experience in the design, delivery of Cultural Awareness Training
- Ability to make presentations to small and large groups
- Demonstrated skills and experience in facilitation and presentation, interpersonal communication and brokerage (as required and defined by the ACCHS)
- Excellent Communication and interpersonal skills
- Strong Written and Communication Skills
- Well-developed sense of personal responsibility, and has a grounded cultural identity

This role will include the following primary responsibilities:

- 1) Support the delivery of education programme for General Practice Registrars
- 2) Participate in a range of activities to promote Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Health Training to ACCHSs, RTOs, Registrars, medical students and other individuals and groups as appropriate
- 3) Participate in workshops as identified by MCCC GP Training

This role is the perfect opportunity to work within a regional dynamic team environment and contribute towards the training of the next generation of General Practice Registrars.
