## Expression of Interest Cultural Mentors

Murray City Country Coast GP Training (MCCC) is a new Regional Training Organisation responsible for the management and delivery of specialist general practice training programs across North Western and North Eastern Victoria, the greater Albury region into Southern New South Wales, central Victoria, South Western Victoria and Northern and Western metropolitan Melbourne area which covers approximately 40% of the population base of Melbourne.

MCCC is seeking expressions of interest from suitably experienced people within our local Aboriginal Community Controlled Health Organisations (ACCHOs) and/or local aboriginal community members to take on these important roles working in collaboration with our Aboriginal Health program staff and educators.

Cultural Mentors will work within ACCHSs to provide support for non-aboriginal staff commencing or recommencing their placement within the local ACCHS.

The Cultural Mentor role at MCCC falls under a service agreement with your employing organisation so this is not a separate employment arrangement. The following attributes are essential:

- Acknowledgement of your Aboriginal heritage
- Experience in working in an Aboriginal organisation
- Demonstrated understanding and knowledge of local Aboriginal culture and history
- Ability to make presentations to small and large groups of people
- Well developed computer skills, including Microsoft programs
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills
- Demonstrated ability to show initiative and manage time effectively
- Able to handle personal data with due regard to confidentiality of information

The role will include the following primary responsibilities:

- work proactively to improve people's understanding of Aboriginal Culture and making ACCHSs culturally safe for all staff
- participate in the development of a new MCCC Cultural Mentor plan with MCCC program staff, VACCHO and Stakeholder Organisation staff
- work collaboratively with all staff to ensure a holistic approach to cultural issues

This is an excellent opportunity to work within a dynamic, team focused environment and contribute towards the training of the next generation of Specialist General Practitioners in your communities.
