## Expressions of Interest

### Medical Educator (ME) Assessors

(hours dependant on number of participants)

The Practice Experience Program is expanding and is now seeking expressions of interest for the casual roles of Assessors to join the existing team of PEP Assessors.

MCCC MEs – Please note that this work can be undertaken out of normal hours, i.e. weekends, and is extremely flexible. Please consider your existing MCCC commitments and it is recommended you discuss your interest with your RHE in the first instance.

Key Responsibilities:

**PEP Assessor** (time allowance 4-5 hours per participant plus travel if required)

Each participant will require one direct observation visit each term at their practice. The direct observation will involve:

- Undertake direct observation of consulting skills. Methods for this include but are not limited to simulated consultations in a group setting, External Clinical Teaching Visits (ECTV), reviewing videotaped consultations or viewing streamed consultations via online media
- Complete a mini-CEX rating form for 4 observed cases and submit to the RACGP PEP portal
- Undertake clinical case analysis. Methods for this include random case analysis and/or case-based discussions
