MCCC is seeking expressions of interest from General Practice Registrars who are training with MCCC under the Australian General Practice Training Program.

The Registrar Liaison Officer will act as liaison between the GP Registrars and MCCC GP Training, represent the views of GP Registrars to MCCC GP Training, facilitate communication between them and provide support to Registrars. RLOs also participate in the educational program for Registrars. This role reports to the Director Medical Education and Training, Dr Angelina Salamone.

Primary responsibilities of this role:

- Act a conduit for feedback from Registrar cohort and disseminate timely and professional information regarding changes to the program as a result of Registrar input
- Liaise with General Practice Registrars Association (GPRA) and other key stakeholders as required to deliver role responsibilities
- Facilitate communication between GP Registrars and MCCC GP Training, sharing views and information, ensuring communication to the GP Registrars aligns with MCCC's requirements, the Colleges' requirements and program objectives and information flows to MCCC from GP Registrars
- Attend meetings to aid in sourcing prospective GP registrars, and provide information about general practice vocational training to prospective GP Registrars
- Act as liaison contact for GP registrars in their hospital training terms to provide flow of information between MCCC and assigned registrars
- Participate in the educational activities of the General Practice Training Program as required
